V. Principal's Report

a. Parent Workshops:

- i. Two workshops scheduled :
 - 1. Save for college workshop for K-2: Friday, January 26 at 10am. Dial in from work or wherever you are.
 - HMH Workshop open to all: In depth workshop scheduled for Friday, February 2, that will be in person at school right after drop-off from 8:20am to 9:15am (new update: Superintendent David Pretto will be in attendance – RSVP here: rmd.me/z8GDgKtQqYe).
- ii. Ruler Workshop: later in February, but there's no date yet.

b. Construction:

- i. Scaffolding is down and roof is done, but need to excavate and close exit to 86th St school so K and 1st grade will be dismissed from front of building because in a few months 87th St will be closed.
- ii. Play Roof looks great, but still having leaks. If there's a leak or any chipped paint, the room with chipped paint is closed until someone checks for asbestos.
- iii. 5th floor and smaller class rooms like 406, 551 will get some new wood floors.
- iv. Will be getting some new water fountains in the cafeteria.
- v. Applying for grant to renovate the cafeteria, including soundproofing.
- c. Tech:
 - i. have iPads, but for K and 1st grade waiting on cases and charging stations, but eventually they'll have it too awarded \$500K grant by borough.
